

# Crew Games & Night Challenges

When the sails are down and the stars are out, it's time for a different kind of sailing — the one made of teamwork, games, and laughter.

Here are a few simple crew activities that fit perfectly with life on board, no matter where you drop the anchor.

## Dinghy Race Challenge

A quick race across the bay using the dinghy or SUP. Each team must reach a buoy and return — style and creativity count as much as speed!

Add a twist: make teams paddle with one oar or wear funny hats for bonus points.

**Tip:** Best done before sunset — easier to recover hats, flip-flops, and pride.

## Card Games & Crew Classics

When the night is calm and music fades, cards bring everyone together.

- **UNO / Crazy Eights** – simple, fast, always fun.
- **Poker Night** – winner chooses tomorrow's breakfast duty.
- **Kings (Drinking Game)** – mix laughter and chaos responsibly.
- **Activity** – guess the word by acting, drawing, or explaining; all words are sea or trip themed.

Keep a waterproof deck or laminated set — humidity kills regular cards fast.
